- The pollution during the manufacture of your product?
- The environmental issues of the components of the product you developed. Such as lead parts.

ETHICS

- Do not copy any part of your report from other sources.
- Mention the existing and already expired patents related to your product. Mention how different your product is.
 - Google patent
 - Patnetstorm
 - European patent office
- Mention if you have or will apply for patent for your product?

SUSTAINABILITY

- Be sure that there will not be any pollution during the manufacture and operation of your work. Confirm that fact in the report.
- How your product may be recycled at the end of the life of the product you develop?

GLOBAL COMPONENT

- Which university or research institution has made relevant research and what they do?
- Which country makes the best products in this field
- Which companies make the best products in your field? Can you cooperate with them?
- Are there any markets for your product in the other countries?

GLOBAL COMPONENT

- May your product work in the other countries
 - Discuss the power supply (Operational voltage range – Many power supplies work 110-240V in these days)
 - Discuss the plugs (Adapters)
